Directions to Camp:

From Lubbock Area: Travel East on US 62/82/114 towards Crosbyton, TX. Go through Crosbyton. Past the city park and cemetery. Make the first left (north) on F.M. 2591 at the bottom of the hill. There are 4 historical markers on the Northeast corner of the intersection of 62/82 and F.M. 2591. The camp gate is on the left side of the road once you cross the White River Bridge.

From Fort Worth Area: Travel West on US 62/82/114 towards Crosbyton, TX. Once you pass Silver Fall rest stop, make the first right (north) on F.M. 2591 at the bottom of the hill. There are 4 historical markers on the Northeast corner of the intersection of 62/82 and F.M. 2591. The camp gate is on the left side of the road once you cross the White River Bridge.
